

**CITY OF EASTLAND
ORDINANCE NO. 750**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE V, (PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS AND ITINERANT VENDORS) SECTION 8-106 TO PROHIBIT SOLICITATION FROM OCCUPANTS OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON ANY PUBLIC STREET.

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of public health to regulate acts or conditions involving peddlers, solicitors, itinerant merchants and vendors that are unlawful within the City of Eastland,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Eastland that Article V, Section 8-106 of the Code of Ordinances be hereby amended to read as follows:

“Sec. 8-106. Soliciting from Motorists

It shall be unlawful for any person, either on foot or in automobiles, for any cause whatsoever, to solicit funds from or distribute any item to, occupants of motor vehicles that are being operated on any public street within the city limits.”

This Ordinance becomes effective upon its passage and after publication as required by law.
